

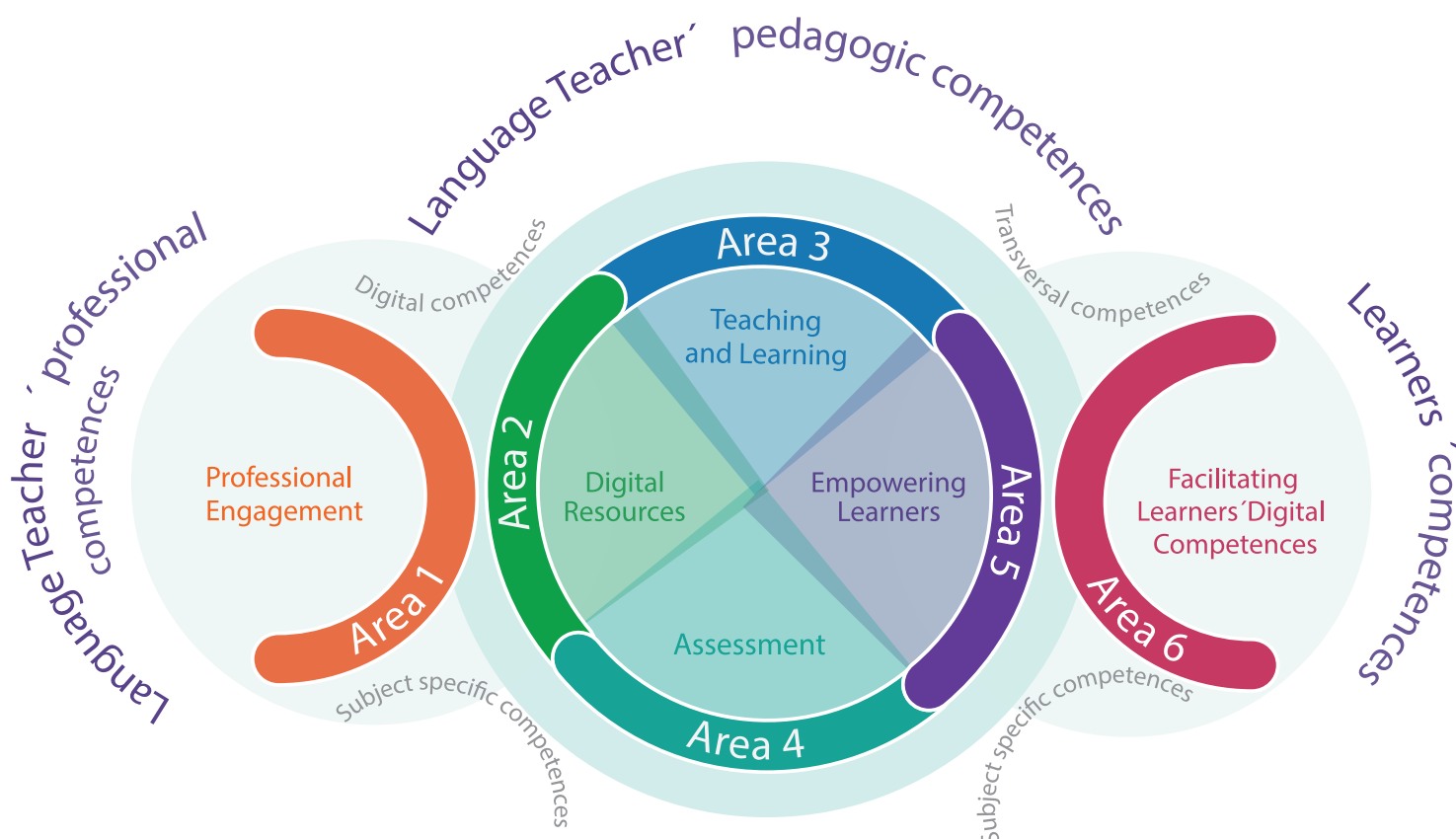
The use of digital technologies in language teaching practice has meanwhile become indispensable. Using interactive exercise books, creating digital content, designing learning materials, changing assessment techniques, strengthening collaborative work and communication in digital learning environments and managing learners interactions as outlined in the Companion Volume of the European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR, 2018) raises new challenges for language teachers, as it implies new digital skill sets that support changes to the traditional pedagogical model and the adaptation to new demands for digital skills.

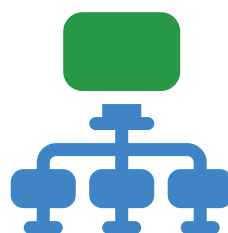

It will also tell you where you might go next to hone further skills or get more information about the different competence areas so you can decide what you might want to work on.

For example, you can test your digital competence in Professional Engagement, for determining how competent you are now in tools that work on networking and connecting professionals in the field. Or you can test your digital competence in Teaching and Learning for identifying a few ideas for improving your competence and learn about useful tools to involve when preparing resources for language learners.

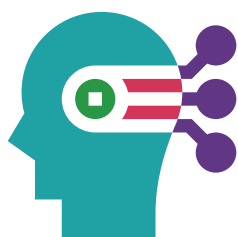
THE IDEAL PLATFORM
