



Integrating Digital Education in Adult Language Teaching (IDEAL)

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Online Training concept

The use of digital technologies in the field of language teaching and learning has long gained a foothold. The movement towards different modes of language teaching, from classroom-based to blended and fully online modes, requires from the profession of language teachers new competences and updated skills for moderating, developing and designing language activities, facilitating active learning and supporting collaborative interaction in digital environments — particularly as the extended and broadened Companion Volume of the European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR, 2018) also includes the area "online communication".

The Online training explores creative solutions for ICT implications in the language teaching in adult education as a hands-on approach.

The training concept includes the following aspects:

- What does the profile of a digitally competent language teacher in adult education imply with regard to the requirements of Digital Competence Framework for Educators (DigCompEdu, 2017) and of CEFR with new descriptors?
- How to benefit from digital competences and innovative digital technologies as a language teacher?
- Practical tips for using digital tools as teaching aids for creating various language communicative activities and preparing worksheets

Target group of the training: language teachers who practice their profession.

Before setting up the online training, it is suggested to watch the following video http://platform.ideal-project.eu/training. This video can be used for self-learning or can support staff in preparation of the online training activity. Below there is a proposal of the 3-day online training programme. In order to run the training programme, online tools like Zoom, Microsoft Teams, Google Meet, Skype etc. can be used.
